

# **Taxi Plate Transactions User Guide**



# 1. Background

#### 1.1. About this document

Taxi Service Providers are required to use the Point to Point Transport Commissioner's Industry Portal for Taxi Plate Transactions.

There are three transactions that must be submitted through the Industry Portal. These transactions include:

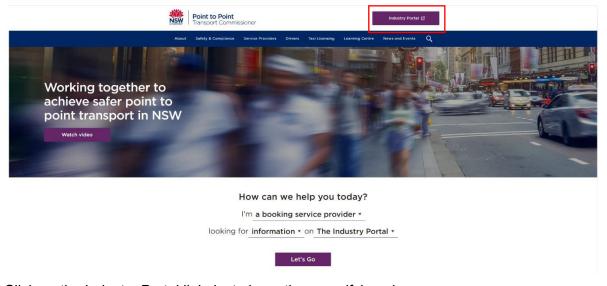
- placing a taxi plate on hold
- taking a taxi plate off hold
- ordering a replacement taxi plate (if it has been damaged, lost or stolen).
- surrendering a taxi plate
- changing a vehicle or registered operator (within one day)

This document will guide you through the process of submitting the above taxi plate transaction applications and details of how the registered operator/owner of the vehicle or an authorised representative can complete the transaction at a Service NSW service centre.

## 2. Using the Industry Portal for Taxi Plate Transactions

## 2.1. How to access the taxi plate transaction form

From your web browser, go to the Point to Point Transport Commissioner's website at <a href="http://www.pointtopoint.nsw.gov.au">http://www.pointtopoint.nsw.gov.au</a>

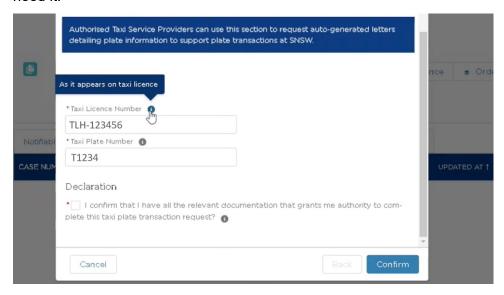

## 2.2. Placing a taxi plate on hold

Once you click on the Taxi Plate Transactions button, you'll be asked to enter the Taxi Licence Number and the Taxi Plate Number that this transaction relates to.

You'll see there is an 'i' icon next to each of these fields which gives more information if you need it.



Once these details have been entered, click on 'confirm'.

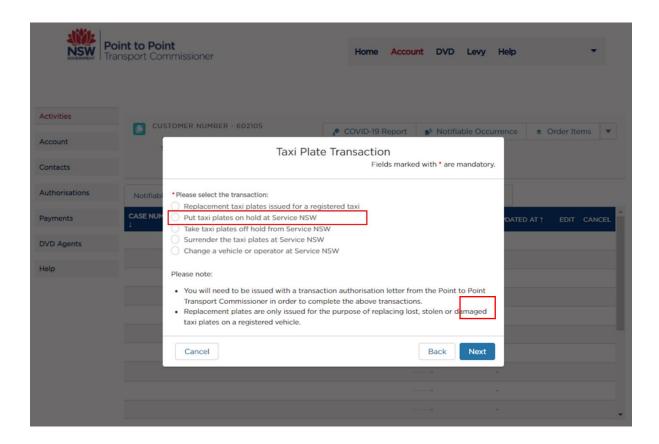

Select 'Put taxi plates on hold at Service NSW' and click 'Next'

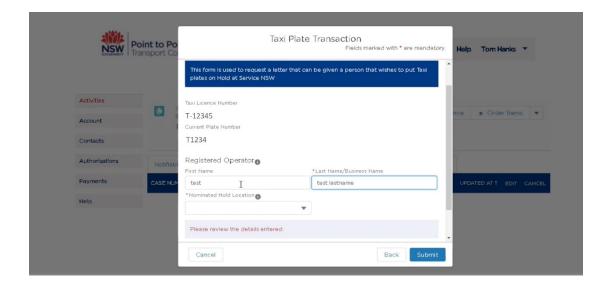


On the next screen you will be asked to enter in the details of the 'Registered Operator'. Enter the first name and last name of the registered operator/owner of the vehicle.
